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David Novell his recognizance taken as aforesaid by this Court here discharged as prayed

June 10th 1734

At the same tenth day of June Anno Domini one Thousand Seven Hundred and thirty four Came Thomas Wright of Kent County Planter before me one of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for the same County and acknowledged himself indebted to the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord prop^r in the Sum of Two pounds Sterling to be made and levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his Lordship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if he shall not make his personall appearance at Kent County Court House on the third Wednesday in June next to give his evidence on his Lordships behalf against a certain William Salisbury Servant to Daniel Perkins. wherewith the same Thomas Wright acknowledges himself to be content. In Testimony whereof I have set my hand this day and year aforesaid

And now here at this Court to wit at Kent County at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in June being the eighteenth day of said Month Anno Domini one Thousand Seven Hundred and thirty four Came the aforesaid the Lord proprietor by Touch Francis his atty and prayed that the aforesaid Thomas Wright might come into Court and appear to his Recognizance as the aforesaid proclamation being made and the aforesaid Thomas Wright being solemnly called came not but made default

Ordered by this Court that William Salisbury give Security for his appearance to next Court to answer unto what shall be objected against him on his Lordships behalf and in the mean time to be of good behavior Thereupon Daniel Perkins of Kent County did come into Court in his proper person and acknowledges himself indebted to the Right Honourable the Lord proprietor of the province of Maryland in the Sum of Twenty pounds Sterling to be made and levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the aforesaid William Salisbury his Servant shall not make his personall appearance at next Court to be hold for Kent County at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in August next to answer unto what shall be objected against him on his Lordships behalf and in the mean time he is to be of good behavior wherewith the same Daniel Perkins acknowledges himself content
