Filing appeal Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, bond to stay ex- That in all cases of appeal from the judgment or decree of any court of this State, wherein an appeal is by law allowed, the filing of an appeal bond, approved as the law prescribes, shall stay any execution which may, or has been, or shall be issued on any such judgment or decree, whether such such execution may have been in part executed or not; provided, that the party requiring the execution to be stayed, shall pay all the costs of the execution; and it shall be the duty of the sheriff or other officer, in whose hands such execution may be, upon the exhibition to him of satisfactory evidence that an appeal bond has been filed and approved, and upon the receipt of the costs which have accrued on the said executions, to stay all further proceedings, and discharge the party from custody, or deliver up the property, as the case may be; provided, that this act shall not extend to appeals from the judgments of courts of common law; rendered by confession, or to any judgment rendered on verdict, unless a bill of exceptions has been taken, or a motion in arrest of judgment has been over-ruled, to the commencement of Com land with
