A supplement to an act, entitled an act to incorporate the Passed Jan. 1, Trustees of Union Town Academy, in Carroll County. 1841.

Whereas, by the second section of an act, entitled an Preamble act to incorporate the trustees of Uniontown academy, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, chapter two hundred and forty-three, it was required that an election should be held on the first day of January, of each and every year thereafter, for trustees; and whereas, the requirements of said sections were not complied with: therefore,
