An act to empower the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Passed Inn. 14, Council of Frederick, to selt the Market House in 1899. West Patrick street, and apply the proceeds to the erection of Public Pumps in Bentz Town, in Frederick.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Authority to sail Marytand, That the Mayor, Aldermen and Common and convey Council of Frederick be authorised, empowered and required to sell, at public or private sale, as in their judgment they may doem best, the market house situate in West Patrick street, in Frederick; and they are
