CHAPTER 1.

An act to amend and make valid a certain instrument Passed Jan. 5, of writing therein mentioned.

WHEREAS, It has been represented to this General Preamble Assembly, that a certain deed was executed, acknowledged and delivered to Jonathan Crane, by William H. Hackett, G. B. Hackett and Sarah C. Hackett, all of Queen Ann's County and State of Maryland, and recorded in Liber J. T. No. 2, folio 187, one of the land records of said county, on the twenty-eighth day
