

CHAP. 196. subject to all the limitations and restrictions imposed upon the Potomac Manufacturing company, incorporated at the present session of the legislature.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this law shall continue in force only until the first Monday of December eighteen hundred and forty-nine, but all incorporations which may be established by virtue of this act shall remain in force till repealed by some subsequent legislature, and shall always be liable to repeal, alteration and amendment at the discretion of subsequent legislatures.

CHAPTER 195.

An act entitled, an act for the relief of Thomas M. D. Baden, former collector of Prince George's county.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the time allowed Thomas M. D. Baden, former collector of taxes in Prince George's county, by the act of December session eighteen hundred and forty-six, chapter three hundred and twenty-nine, be and the same is hereby extended to the first day of January eighteen hundred and forty-nine.

A further supplement to an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail Road Company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That from and after the day when any company or companies now or hereafter incorporated for the purpose by the legislature of Pennsylvania shall have completed a rail road or rail roads, either from the borough of York to the Cumberland Valley road, or from the borough of Wrightsville to a junction with the Harrisburg, Mount Joy and Lancaster rail road, or to the town of Harrisburg, thereby securing a connection with the Pennsylvania rail road on the east bank of the Susquehanna river, the arrearages of interest due from the Baltimore and Susquehanna rail road company to the State of Maryland, upon loans made to that company, shall be funded
