Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Librarian be authorised to allow C. W. Webster to retain the books furnished him from the library until the first day of January eighteen hundred and fifty, for the purpose of enabling the said Webster to complete his Compilation of the Statute Laws of the State of Maryland; *provided*, that nothing herein contained shall be considered as to authorise the said Webster to expect any pecuniary aid from the State on the completion of said work, or any subscription to the same on the part of the State, after it shall have been completed.
