AN ACT to incorporate the Mutual Insurance Company of Somerset and Worcester counties.

Incorporated.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That John White, Purnell Toadvine, William Birkhead, William J. Leonard, William H. Rider, Humphrey Humphreys, William Freeny, William S. Parsons, Isaac H. W. Standford, Thomas B. Moore, Isaac Nichols, John W. Taylor, John W. Crisfield, William T. G. Polk, John Dougherty, George S. Richardson, John R. Franklin, William E. Timmons, Zadock Henry, Cyrus L. Williams, John Derickson, James Whaley, James M. Fooks, Levin M. Dashiels and John Gunby, and all other persons, who may hereafter associate with them in the manner herein prescribed, be and they are hereby incorporated by the name of the Mutual Insurance Company of Somerset and Worcester counties, for the purpose of insuring their respective dwelling houses, manufactories, mills, stores, shops, and other buildings, merchandise, household furniture, and other property, against loss and damage by fire, and by such name shall have succession, to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded in any court of law or equity in this State, to have, make and use a common seal, and the same to break, alter and renew at pleasure.
