Mr. Waters submitted the following order:

Ordered, That the committee on the constitution be requested to report to this House at as early a day as practicable, a bill to provide for a convention to reform the constitution of this State, and that the committee be instructed to provide in said bill for submitting the question of a convention to the people at the next general election.

Said order was read, and on the question being put, will the House adopt the said order?

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Giles reported a bill entitled, a supplement to the act of Assembly, passed December session 1838, ch. 333, entitled, an act to aid in the construction of a State Armory and Town Hall in the city of Baltimore, and the re-building and improvement of the Hanover market house in said city;

Read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Gallagher reported a bill entitled, an act to divorce Caroline Dimmitt from her husband Washington Dimmitt;

Read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Welch, of Annapolis, chairman of the committee on elections, made the following report from the majority of said committee:
