Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it is not and shall not be lawful for any individual, association or corporation, directly or indirectly to issue, pay out, receive or deliver, or attempt to emit or circulate, or to print or cause to be printed, or to cause any plate to be engraved for any such purpose, any bill, note, scrip note, certificate, token or device whatever, representing or intended to represent, or purporting to form any portion of, or evidence of claim, to any portion of or interest in any share of, or (unless where the same has been authorised by law,) of any share of the stock of any corporate company, or any bond or other obligation of any state or corporation whatever, or of any subdivided part of the same; and that any such emission, issuing or paying out of any such note, bill, scrip, note, token or device, already made, is in contravention of existing laws, the same being an intent to circulate a currency, not recognized by this state;

Mr. Giles moved to make the said resolution the order of the day for Thursday next;
