Read and referred to the committee on education.

Mr. Winder asked and obtained leave to withdraw from the files of the house, the exhibit to the petition of John B. Taylor, of Somerset county, presented at this session.

The clerk of the senate delivered the following bills,

A bill entitled, an act to authorise Wallace Kirkwood, trustee of Clement Kennedy, to bring into this state certain negro slaves; Endorsed "will pass."

Read the first time and referred to the committee on the colored population.

Also, returned the bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Cecil county, to levy a sum of money, to be appropriated to the erection of a bridge over the North East Creek, at or near Johnson's factory;

Endorsed, will pass, with the proposed amendment,

Amendment proposed:

At the end of the second section add "who shall give bond and security to be approved by the aforesaid county commissioners."

Said amendment was read the second time by special order and assented to, and the bill as amended ordered to be engrossed.

Also, returned the bill entitled, an act to encourage the emigration of free people of color from this state;

Endorsed, will pass, with the proposed amendment,

Amendment proposed.

Strike out the word "and" at the beginning of the first section,

Insert the word "and" before the word "be" second and third sections;

Said amendment was read the second time by special order, assented to, and the bill as amended, ordered to be engrossed.
