Mr. Waters moved to amend the said substitute, by adding thereto the following, as an additional section;

"Be it enacted, That a similar grant, as is provided by this Bill, in favor of Harford county, is hereby made in favor of Montgomery county, and that commissioners may be appointed by the "county commissioners" of Montgomery county, with full power and authority to carry said grant into effect; and the proceeds of said grant shall be applied to erecting a bridge over Seneca creek, at Middle creek mills, on the Frederick and Georgetown road, also, for building a bridge over Bennitt's creek, at Hyatt's town, on said road; and for grading some of the hills on said road between said bridges;"

Which was read.
