Which was read the first time, and laid on the table.

Also delivered the following bills:

The bill entitled, an act to give to the chancellor and the county courts, as courts of equity, jurisdiction in cases of divorce;

And the bill entitled, an act to divorce Abraham Cuyk from his wife Susan L. Cuyk;

Severally endorsed "will pass;"

Read the first time and referred to the committee on divorces.

Mr. Graves asked and obtained leave to bring in a bill to incorporate the Superannuated Fund Society of the Maryland Annual Conference;"

Referred to the committee on corporations.

On motion of Mr. Graves,

"Ordered, That the committee to whom was referred the answers of banks and other institutions and corporations, to certain interrogatories under order of the 1st January, be instructed to repeat said interrogatories directly to such institutions and corporations as have not made answer to the same, and to such other institutions or corporations, whose answers may not be satisfactory, and that if answers to said interrogatories be not made on or before the 17th inst. the house take immediate action thereon as a contempt of this body."

The clerk of the Senate returned the bill entitled, an act incorporating the Baltimore College of Dental Surgery;

Endorsed "will pass" with the proposed amendment;

Amendment proposed,

In the 6th line of the 2d section, strike out the name Horace H. Hayden, and insert the name of "H. Willis Baxley;"

Which was read the first and by special order the second time, assented to, and the bill as amended, ordered to be engrossed.

On motion of Mr. Selby,

The house adjourned until Monday morning 10 o'clock.
