

The undersigned a member of the committee, on the affairs of the Eastern Shore Rail Road Company, concurs in the report of the majority of the committee who have reported in obedience to the order of the 29th ult. except in so far as the committee express the positive opinion that the payments by the private stockholders have not been made agreeably to the intent of the resolution of the last session.
