

accurate account of the monies that are paid into the treasury by the city of Baltimore, Howard District and the several counties in this state, under the provisions of this bill; and the said city, district and counties, respectively, be authorised, through their corporate authorities, levy courts, or commissioners, respectively, to commute the sums of money so paid by them into the treasury, into so much of the State's stock in the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, as may equal the amounts respectively paid by them, whenever the said canal company shall be able to pay 6 per cent. upon the said stock; and the Treasurer of the Western Shore is hereby directed to cause the necessary transfers of stock to be made to the said city, district or counties, respectively, and they shall be considered stockholders in said canal company, and thereafter be entitled to receive the dividends that may accrue on the amounts of stock so held by them, respectively."
