

Mr. Graves from the committee of Ways and Means, made an unfavorable report upon the bill entitled, an act to provide for the payment of an income tax by the officers of incorporated companies;

Which was read the first time,

On motion of Mr. Raymond,

Said bill was recommitted.

Mr. Stansbury, of Baltimore county, reported a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Great Gunpowder Falls Manufacturing Company;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Corporations.

Mr. Gallagher reported a bill entitled, an act to change the name of Sarah E. Morrison, of the city of Baltimore, to that of Sarah E. Meritt.

Mr. Gallagher, chairman of the committee on Corporations, reported a bill entitled, a supplement to an act passed 1842, ch. 298, entitled, an act to incorporate the Hopewell Academy in Montgomery county :

Mr. Ford, of Queen Anne's, reported a bill entitled, an act to authorise the assignment of certain indentures therein mentioned ;

Mr. Long reported a bill entitled, an act for the benefit of the trustees of the Presbyterian church at Fork town, in Worcester county, and

Mr. Patterson reported a bill entitled, a supplement to an act passed at December session 1841, ch. 182, entitled, an act to provide for the election of the commissioners of Montgomery county, by the people ;

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Gallagher, chairman of the committee on Corporations, made a favorable report upon the bill from the Senate entitled, an act to incorporate the New York Mining Company ;

Mr. Freeman from the select committee, made a favorable report upon the bill from the Senate, entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Charles county, to cause the bridge across Allen's Fresh Run in said county, to be repaired or rebuilt ;

Mr. Long, chairman of the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, made an unfavorable report on the bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to give to the Chancellor and county courts, as courts of equity, jurisdiction in cases of divorce, passed December session 1841, ch. 262 ;

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The House resumed the consideration of the bill reported by Mr. Neff, entitled, an act to incorporate the Frostburg coal company, being the unfinished business of the 12th instant.
