Resolved in the affirmative.

Mr. Long moved to amend said bill by inserting after the word "postponed," in the 4th section 3rd line, the words "for a period not exceeding ten years;"

Mr. Morsell moved to amend said amendment by striking out "ten years," and inserting in lieu thereof the words "fifteen years;"

Mr. Ford, of St. Mary's moved to amend said amendment by striking out "ten years," and inserting "twenty years,"

The question then recurred and was put on the motion of Mr. Long, to insert after the word "postponed," in the 4th section 3rd line the words, "for a period not exceeding ten years," and

Determined in the negative.
