So the amendment was rejected.

On motion of Mr. Hollyday, of Cecil,

Said bill was amended by inserting after the word "thereon," in the 5th section sixth line the following "the rate per cent for which the same was hypothecated or sold."

Mr. Calvert moved further to amend said bill by striking out in the 8th section after the words "and be it enacted," to the end of said section and inserting in lieu thereof, the following :

Section 8. "That the State of Maryland hereby reserves to itself the right of requiring the said Canal Company to extend a branch of said canal or other improved navigation from the town of Cumberland to the coal banks at or near the mouth of Savage river, whenever hereafter it shall appear to the Legislature that the public interest will be advanced by such extension, and of providing for payment of the expenses of making said extension out of the profits of said work, and out of one half part of the tolls which may be received by the Canal Company for the use of the main canal in the transportation from Cumberland eastwardly of articles which may be supplied, from the said extension to the main canal at Cumberland; and the residue of said profits and tolls shall be paid into the Treasury of the State to be applied in payment of the State's liens on the revenues of the Canal Company;"

Which was read.

Mr. Kilgour called for a division of the question, which was put on striking out, and

Resolved in the affirmative.
