

Also, the bill entitled, an act to extend to Baltimore county, the provisions of an act relating to the lien of mechanics and others on buildings;

And the resolution appointing directors on the part of the State in the Baltimore and Ohio rail road company;

Were sent to the Senate.

The Speaker presented a memorial of sundry citizens of the city of Baltimore, praying for a change in the license laws in relation to hawkers and pedlars;

Which was read and referred to the select committee already appointed on that subject.

Mr. Gallagher presented two memorials, one signed by Doctor G. M. Roberts, T. Hanson Belt, and others of the city of Baltimore, the other signed by George F. Adams, and other citizens of Hereford in Baltimore county, severally praying an alteration in the license laws;

Which were severally read and referred to the select committee appointed on that subject.

Mr. Gallagher presented the memorial of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, in relation to the extension of Bel-Air market space;

Which was read and referred to the Baltimore city delegation.

Mr. Fitzpatrick presented the memorial of John M. Carlson, and one hundred and five citizens of Allegany county praying for an act of incorporation to be known by the name of "Brauts Enterprise;"

Which was read and referred to the committee on Corporations.

Mr. Johnson, of Anne Arundel, presented the memorial of John L. Donaldson, and others, for refunding taxes improperly paid;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

Mr. Springer presented the memorial of sundry citizens of Baltimore city and county, praying for the passage of a law therein mentioned;

Which was read and referred to the Baltimore city delegation.

Mr. Clarke presented the petition of Benjamin Swingley, of Washington county, praying the passage of a law to extend the time of his collection of the State tax for 1843;

Which was read and referred to Washington county delegation.

Mr. Clarke presented the petition of sundry citizens of Washington county, praying the passage of a law to incorporate the Washington county Mutual Insurance Company;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Corporations.
