

On motion of Mr. Fooks,

Said bill was referred to the delegations from Worcester and Queen Anne's counties.

The bill reported by Mr. Harrington, entitled, an act for the benefit of Elizabeth Hunt of Talbot county:

Was taken up for consideration,

Read the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

The bill from the Senate entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Cuba Smelting and Mining Company;

Was taken up for consideration, and

Read the second time.

On motion of Mr. Calvert,

Said bill was amended by striking out the 8th section thereof;

The said bill was then passed with the proposed amendment and returned to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Lynch from the committee on Corporations, entitled, an act to incorporate the United Manufacturing Company of Maryland;

Was taken up for consideration;

On motion of Mr. Gallagher,

Said bill was amended by adding at the end thereof as an additional section the following:

"And be it enacted, That this act shall remain in force for thirty years, and that the Legislature reserves to itself the right to change, alter or repeal this act of incorporation at pleasure;"

The said bill was then read the second time as amended, passed and sent to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. McKnett, entitled, an act to establish a division line between district school No. 1, in the lower election district of Caroline county and the Federalsburg academy, was taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Poole, entitled, an act to reduce the number of the justices of the levy court of Frederick county, and to divide the county into levy court districts for electing the same;

Was taken up for consideration and read the second time,

Mr. Biser moved to lay said bill on the table;

Determined in the negative.

The question then recurred upon the passage of said bill;

Mr. Biser then offered as a substitute for said bill, the following:

A further supplement, to an act entitled, an act to provide for the election of the Justices of the Levy Court of Frederick county by the people, passed at December session eighteen hundred and forty-two, chapter two hundred and fifty-five.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the present members of the Levy Court of Frederick county, elected under the act of December session eighteen hundred and forty-two, chapter two hundred and fifty-five, be and they
