

all the power, rights and authority, and be subject to the same qualifications, perform all the duties and make all the appointments, that the Justices of the Levy Court of said county have heretofore had and exercised, and which they would have, if elected and commissioned under the act to which this is a further supplement.

Section 7. And be it enacted, That all acts and part of acts of Assembly so far as they are inconsistent with this act, be and they are hereby repealed.

Which was read,

On the question being put,

"Will the House accept the substitute?"

It was determined in the negative.

So the House refused to accept the substitute.

The question then recurred upon the passage of the bill.

Mr. Biser moved to amend said bill by inserting as the 9th section thereof the following:

"Sec. 9 And be it further enacted, That the collector of taxes for Frederick county, shall hereafter be elected biennially at the elections held for electing members of the House of Delegates, and the first election for collector shall be at the next annual election for members of the House of Delegates, and the person so elected shall hold his office for two years ;"
