

On motion of Mr. Purnell,

Leave was granted the Worcester county delegation, to bring in a bill to be entitled, a supplement to an act of December session 1840, ch. 215.

On motion of Mr. Hollyday, of Cecil,

Leave was granted the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, to bring in a bill entitled, an act to provide for the admission of the Statues of the several States as evidence in the courts of this State.

The bill reported by Mr. Stewart, entitled, an act to allow James Morris and Milton Welsh, further time to complete their collections ;

Was taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Gallagher, chairman of the committee on Corporations, entitled, an act to incorporate the Chesapeake and Liberia Trading company ;

Was taken up for consideration,

On motion of Mr. Calvert,

Said bill was amended by adding at the end thereof, as an additional section, the following :

"And be it enacted, That the Legislature hereby reserves the right at any time hereafter to alter, amend or repeal this charter;"

The said bill was then read the second time as amended, passed and sent to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Lankford, from the committee on Corporations, entitled, an act to incorporate the trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church of Hagerstown ;

Was taken up for consideration,

On motion of Mr. Biser,

Said bill was amended by adding at the end thereof, as an additional section, the following :

"And be it enacted, That the Legislature reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal this corporation at its pleasure ;"

The said bill was then read the second time as amended, passed and sent to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Clarke, from the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, entitled, an act for the benefit of John Clay of the city of Philadelphia, in the State of Pennsylvania ;

The bill reported by Mr. Walker, entitled, an act to allow John Moke, late collector of Baltimore county, further time to complete his collections ;

The bill reported by Mr. Patterson, entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to consolidate the duties of the levy court and commissioners of tax for Montgomery county, and prescribe their duties ;

The bill reported by Mr. Hollyday, of Cecil, entitled, an act authorising and empowering the commissioners of Cecil county,
