Which motion he waived, for the purpose of enabling the following bills to be reported:

Mr. Calvert, from the select committee, made a favorable report upon the bill from the Senate, entitled, an act to authorize Henry L. Carlton, late collector in Prince George's county, to complete his collections;

Also, reported a bill entitled, an act to indemnify persons for stock killed or injured on the various rail roads of the State;

Mr. Archer reported a bill entitled, an act for the relief of Rachel Lee, of Harford county; and

Mr. Morsell, chairman of the committee on Inspections, reported a bill entitled, an act to provide for furnishing nails for the Tobacco warehouses in the city of Baltimore;

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The clerk of the Senate returned the resolution in favor of William McNier;

Endorsed "assented to," and ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Frostburg coal company;

Endorsed will pass, and ordered to be engrossed.

Also, delivered the following bills originated in and passed by the Senate.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of the securities of Israel Mabury, late collector of taxes of Allegany county;

Also, a bill entitled, an act for the relief of Thomas Dowden, late sheriff of Allegany county, and to enable him to complete his collections;

Which were severally read and referred to the Allegany county delegation.

A bill entitled, an act to close Richmond street or road in the city of Baltimore, and to open part of Garden street;

Which was read and referred to the Baltimore city delegation.

And a bill entitled, an act to authorise Henry L. Carlton, late collector of Prince George's county, to complete his collections;

Which was read and referred to the Prince George's county delegation.

The House then adjourned until to-morrow morning 9 o'clock.
