

On motion of Mr. Worthington, of Baltimore county,

Leave was granted the Baltimore county delegation, to bring in a bill entitled, an act to confirm and make valid a deed from Thomas Bosley, to Charles Jessop and others; and also, a deed from Daniel Bosley to Thomas Bosley.

On motion of Mr. Muse,

Leave was granted Messrs. Muse, Shriver and Graves, to bring in a bill respecting boarding houses.

On motion of Mr. Kilgour.

Leave was granted the Montgomery county delegation, to bring in a bill for the benefit of Samuel T. Stonestreet, trustee of Brice Selby, late clerk of Montgomery county court.

Mr. Gallagher, chairman of the committee on Corporations, made an unfavorable report upon the bill reported by Mr. Buckey, entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Fredericktown Savings Institution;

Which was read and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Hughes, chairman of the committee on Education, to whom was referred a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Central Baltimore College, reported the same with the following amendments:

Strike out the "6th section," and add the following section:

"And be it enacted, That the legislature hereby reserves the right at any time hereafter to alter, amend or repeal this charter;"

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time, assented to and sent to the Senate.
