Mr. Goldsborough moved to amend said bill by inserting in the second section, eighth line, after the word "estate" the words, "the assessed value of which exceeds five hundred dollars;"

"Provided, that nothing herein contained shall be taken or held to charge with a duty any second or other copy of a bill of lading or charter party;"

Mr. Frazier moved further to amend said second section by adding at the end thereof, the following proviso:

"Provided, that the owners or agents of articles transported shall pay the tax on said bills of lading;"

Said section was amended by inserting after the word "otherwise," in the 10th line, the words "and whether made or issued by any incorporated institution, individual or firm;"
