

Which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

On motion of Mr. Morsell,

Leave was granted the Calvert county delegation, to bring in a bill for the relief of William Ireland, late collector of Calvert county.

Also, leave was granted the same committee, to bring in a bill for the relief of Francis Stevens, late sheriff of Calvert county.

Mr. Springer reported a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Paradise Company;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Corporations.

Mr. Springer reported a bill entitled, an act supplemental to an act providing for the appointment of lime inspectors in the city of Baltimore, and prescribing their duties, passed December session 1839, ch. 290;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Inspections.

Mr. Buckey reported a bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act authorising the levy court of Frederick county in their discretion to levy a sum of money therein mentioned; and

Mr. Worthington, of Baltimore county, reported a bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Baltimore county, to divide in equal proportions between the city and county of Baltimore, the Baltimore and Havre De Grace road stock, standing in the name of the levy court of Baltimore county, and for other purposes;

Which were severally read the first and second time by special order, passed and sent to the Senate.

The doorkeeper having returned, reported, that in obedience to order, he had notified the absent members that their attendance in the House was required.

The House then resumed the consideration of the motion of Mr. Tall, to reconsider the vote of the House on Saturday last, striking out the enacting clause of the bill entitled, an act imposing duties on promissory notes, bills of exchange, specialties, and other instruments of writing, to aid in paying the debts of the State.

Pending this motion, and after debate thereon,

At three o'clock, P. M. Mr. Archer moved that the House adjourn;

Resolved in the affirmative.

Mr. Bouchell called for the yeas and nays, which call was not sustained by the House.

And the House accordingly adjourned until to-morrow morning 9 o'clock.
