

The question then recurred upon the original bill ;

On motion of Mr. Williams, of Baltimore city,

The House suspended the rule to enable him to offer the following order :

Ordered, That this House will hold evening sessions every day, to commence at      o'clock, during the residue of this session, including this day ;

Mr. Worthington, of Baltimore county, moved to fill the blank in said order with "seven ;"

Mr. Worthington, of Anne Arundel, moved to fill the blank with "five ;"

The question was first taken on the motion of Mr. Worthington, of Baltimore county, on filling the blank with "seven," being the largest number, and

Resolved in the affirmative.

The said order was then adopted.

The House then resumed the consideration of the order of the day, being the bill entitled, an act to provide for the completion of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal to Cumberland, and for other purposes ;

Mr. Archer, (seconded by two other members that voted in the majority,) moved to reconsider the vote of the House upon the substitute, being the bill entitled, an act to create a Board of Public Works, and for other purposes ;

Determined in the negative.

The question then recurred upon the passage of the bill entitled, an act to provide for the completion of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal to Cumberland, and for other purposes ;

Mr. Morsell moved to amend said bill by inserting in the first section, thirteenth line, after the word "paid," "provided their salaries shall not amount to a greater sum than is now paid said officers ;"

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Calvert moved to amend said 1st section of the bill by adding at the end thereof the following proviso :

"Provided however, that the said company shall not make any contract by which the completion of the whole work to Cumberland, shall not be properly and fully secured to be approved of by the State's agents ;"

Resolved in the affirmative.

Mr. Archer moved to amend said bill by striking out in the 2nd section, 14th line, the word "revenues," and inserting in lieu thereof the following, "nett revenues of that part of said canal lying above dam number six ;"
