The committee on Public Printing beg leave to report, that they have contracted with Messrs. Riley and Davis, for the printing required for the use of the House of Delegates, at the following prices, to wit:

For printing 1600 copies House Journal, at \$2 per page, each page to contain 1450 ems.

For printing 114 copies of Reports, Documents, &c., page same size as Journal, at \$1 per page.

For printing tabular pages, double the above prices.

For preparing Index to House Journal, \$150.

The paper and execution of the work not to be inferior to that of the last session.
