 Lord one thousand seven hundred & twenty seven at Between
 John Giles of Baltimore County & province of Maryland Gent
 of one part And John England of Principio in Cecil County
 in the province of the other part Witnesseth that the said John
 Giles for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred pounds
 Sterl money of Great Britain & twenty pounds Curr money of
 Maryland to him in hand paid and secured to be paid
 by the said John England before the sealing & Delivery hereof the
 Receipt whereof the said John Giles doth hereby confess & acknowledge
 And thereof doth acquit exonerate and forever Discharge
 the said John England his Exrs Adms & Assigns by these presents
 Hath Demised granted bargained and sold & by these
 presents doth demise grant bargain & sell unto the said John England
 all and all manner of Iron ore and Stores of Iron ore what-
 soever In or upon a certain point or parcel of Land called
 Whitstone point Situate and lying upon Patapsco River
 in the County of Baltimore and province aforesaid Bounded as
 followeth Vizt Beginning at the House wherein the said John
 Giles now Dwelleth upon the Northwest branch of Patapsco
 River by a line drawn from thence Southwest to a certain point
 untill it intersects Patapsco river and then w^{ch} the
