Now This Indenture Witnesseth ^{that} that the said John Locke for and to the Intent that the said Clement Hill, Basil Warring and Henry Rozier or either of them Their or either of their Heirs Executors or Administrators shall and may be well and truly satisfied Recompenced Contented paid and saved harmless for all and singular such Bills bonds or Obligations which they the said Clement Hill Basil Warring and Henry Rozier have heretofore made or hereafter shall jointly make with the said John Locke, Hath given Granted Bargained and Sold and by these Presents doth give grant Bargain and Sell unto the said Clement Hill Basil Warring and Henry Rozier their Heirs and Assigns for ever all that Tract or parcel of Land called Graiden whereon the Dwelling House of the said John Locke now stands together with all the other the several Tracts

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
