Ex: This Indenture made the tenth Day of February in the year
of our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred and forty six Between
Ferdinando Brewer of Annapondell County Planter of the one Part &
Thomas Sparrow of Annapondell County Planter of the other Part Witnesseth
that it is covenanted concluded and agreed ^{upon} between the Parties to these
Presents for them and their Heirs that it shall and may be lawful
for the said Thomas Sparrow before the last day of the next Provincial
Court to prosecute out of the High Court of Chancery one or more writs or writs
of Entry sur Disseisin in the Port against the said Ferdinando Brewer
Returnable to the next Provincial Court whereby the said Thomas Sparrow
shall and may Demand against the said Ferdinando Brewer one
Moidty of that Part of a Tract or Parcel of Plantable Land with the
appurtenances called Brewerston lying in Annapondell County Begin-
ning at a Cornered white Oak being the second Corner of the
Original Survey of the whole Tract, thence South by East one hundred
and thirty Perches thence west by South three hundred and twenty
Perches, thence North by west one hundred and thirty Perches thence
by a straight line to the first Corner by such Name or Names
Quantity or Quantities of acres as shall be thought fit and requisite
to which with or wits the said Ferdinando Brewer shall appear
in Proper Person and shall Vouch over to warrantee the Common
Vouches, and the Common Vouches shall appear and Imparole
(and)
