(C) (1) NOT LATER THAN JANUARY 1, 1974, THE SECRETARY OF EACH PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH AND THE HEAD OF EACH AGENCY OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH NOT ASSIGNED TO A PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AN ORGANIZATIONAL CHART OF HIS DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY. THE CHART SHALL SHOW THE MAJOR UNITS WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY AND SHALL LIST THE NAME AND TITLE OF THE PERSON IN CHARGE OF EACH, ALL AS OF DECEMBER 1, 1973, AND SHALL INCLUDE A CONCISE DESCRIPTION OF THE FUNCTIONS OF THESE MAJOR UNITS. ANY DEPARTMENT SECRETARY OR AGENCY HEAD SUBMITTING AN ORGANIZATIONAL CHART TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL CAUSE TO BE FILED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE A COPY OF THE CHART.

(2) ON OR BEFORE THE OPENING DAY OF EACH REGULAR SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BEGINNING IN 1975, THE SECRETARY OR THE HEAD OF EACH DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY SHALL SUBMIT ANY REVISIONS OR CORRECTIONS IN ANY PREVIOUSLY SUBMITTED CHART AND SHALL CAUSE TO BE FILED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE A COPY OF ANY REVISION OR CORRECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That new Sections 15CA through 15CE are hereby added to Article 41 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1971 Replacement Volume), title "Governor- Executive and Administrative Departments," under the new subtitle "Executive Orders," to follow immediately after Section 15C thereof and to read as follows:

#### EXECUTIVE ORDERS

15CA.

(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE, THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) "EXECUTIVE ORDER" MEANS

(1) A WRITTEN ORDER, PROCLAMATION, OR DIRECTIVE ISSUED OVER THE GOVERNOR'S SIGNATURE:

(I) PURSUANT TO ARTICLE II, §24 OF THE CONSTITUTION;

(II) PURSUANT TO §§ 3A, 14A, OR 15B OF THIS ARTICLE;

(III) IN THE EXERCISE OF AUTHORITY GRANTED TO THE GOVERNOR BY § 15C OF THIS ARTICLE OR BY ANY OTHER LAW DEALING WITH ORGANIZATION OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH, BOTH WITHIN AND BETWEEN DEPARTMENTS, UNITS AND AGENCIES OF THAT BRANCH;

(IV) ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE, BOARD, COMMISSION, COMMITTEE OR ADVISORY OR STUDY UNIT: OR
