

THE TOWN, CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, ABOVE EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE, WHO SHALL HAVE BONA FIDE RESIDENCE IN THE TOWN FOR SIX (6) MONTHS NEXT PRECEDING THE ELECTION AT WHICH THEY SHALL OFFER TO VOTE AND WHO SHALL HAVE BEEN DULY REGISTERED AS HEREINAFTER PROVIDED, SHALL BE ENTITLED TO VOTE FOR SAID PRESIDENT AND COMMISSIONERS.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the date of adoption of this Resolution is the 16th day of October, 1972, and the amendment to the charter of the Town of North East by the Mayor and Commissioners of said Town hereby proposed by this enactment, shall become effective fifty (50) days after final enactment, unless a proper petition for referendum hereof shall be filed as permitted by law, provided a complete and exact copy of this Resolution shall be posted in the Town Hall of North East for a period of forty (40) days following enactment of said Resolution, and provided further, that a copy of the proposed Amendment shall be published in the "Cecil Whig" or "Cecil Democrat," a newspaper of general circulation in the Town of North East once in each of the weeks of

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of North East be and they are hereby specifically enjoined and instructed to carry out the provisions as contained herein, and as evidence of said compliance they shall cause to be affixed to the Minutes of this meeting appropriate certification of publication of the newspaper in which the title of this Resolution shall have been published and shall declare the charter amendment hereby enacted to be effective by affixing the signature of the Mayor in the space provided on the effective date hereof.

The date of enactment of this Resolution for charter amendment is the 16th day of October, 1972, and said charter amendment shall become effective fifty (50) days from this date, or the 5th day of December, 1972.

AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER

OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN CITY, MARYLAND

I, Harry W. Kelley, Mayor of the Town of Ocean City, Maryland, a Maryland municipal corporation, being the chief executive officer of said municipal corporation, do hereby give notice to the Secretary of State of Maryland and to the State Department of Legislative Reference, that the Charter of the Town of Ocean City, Maryland, has been amended as follows:
