AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER

OF THE TOWN OF OCEAN CITY, MARYLAND

I, Harry W. Kelley, Mayor of the Town of Ocean City, Maryland, a Maryland municipal corporation, being the chief executive officer of said municipal corporation, do hereby give notice to the Secretary of State of Maryland and to the State Department of Legislative Reference, that the Charter of the Town of Ocean City, Maryland, has been amended as follows:

1. Section Amended - SECTION 185 - "FILING STATEMENTS OF CANDIDACY" Complete text of resolution amending said section of said charter is attached hereto. The date of the resolution is 21 February 1972.

2. Referendum Election - There was no Referendum Election nor was there any Petition for Referendum filed.

3. Effective Date - Said amendment became effective 50 days after the date of resolution, said effective date therefore being 12 April 1972.

4. Votes Cast - The amendment was by way of legislative enactment by a unanimous vote of 7 Councilmen for and none against and was thereupon approved by the Mayor, Harry W. Kelley.
