Senate Bill No. 1109—By Senator Curran (Departmental):

An Act to repeal Section 94 of Article 100 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume and 1972 Supplement), title "Work, Labor and Employment," subtitle "Maryland Wage Payment and Collection Law," and to enact new Section 94 in lieu thereof, to stand in the place of the section repealed, relating generally to wage payment and collection; imposing requirements as to the regularity, frequency and medium of wage payments and permissible deductions therefrom; establishing requirements in the event of termination; imposing certain duties upon employers; providing for exceptions, conditions, civil and criminal penalties, and conferring duties as to enforcement upon the Commissioner of Labor and Industry and the Attorney General of Maryland.

The President put the question: Shall the bill pass notwithstanding the objections of the Executive?
