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Thereupon Command is given on this Nineteenth Day
of November in the Twentieth year of our Lord Dominions
Ann Dom One thousand seven Hundred thirty and
four To the Sheriff of Kent County that he shall take
George Garnett of Hester Town Hundred in the County
aforesaid and if he shall be found in his Bailiwick
and him safe keep so that he have his body before our
Justices of Said County Courts to be held at our Court house
for the town of Hester in Said County of the third
Tuesday of November Instant to answer unto certain
Informations for not repairing in person to the dwelling
house of a certain Thomas Thimsey of the said Hundred
and County plasterer and there require a true list
under his hand of all his taxable persons distinctly
to be made which he had in his family but so to do
Altogether did Neglect against the form of the Act
of Assembly in such case made &c and that the
Sheriff of Kent County have at the time and place
aforesaid the said Writ &c

At which said third Tuesday of November
being the Nineteenth day of said Month Anno Dom.
Seventeen Hundred thirty and four the day of Return
of said Writ Came John Gresham Gentle Sheriff of
Kent County and made Return thereof to the Court
