

Such for value and provided and that two Hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco half the above and sum of five Hundred pounds of tobacco be applied to the use of his Lordship and the remaining two Hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco be applied for and to the free School in said County and it is also considered that the same Benj: Sutton pay the sum of Three Hundred and thirty five pounds of tobacco as to remaining on the premises and to the Officers of this Court

Ordered by this Court that the said Benj: Sutton give security for the part of the fine and due to his Lordship in the judgement above specified

Thereupon the same Benj: Sutton here into Court comes and also William Clarke of Kent County planter being present in Court in his proper person and they acknowledge themselves indebted to the Right Honorable the Lord property in the sum of two Hundred pounds of tobacco each to be levied on their bodies goods & chattels lands & ornaments to the use of said Lordship his heirs and successors conditionally that if the said Benj: Sutton shall not pay to his said Lordship his Agent or order the sum of two Hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco the part of the fine in the judgement aforesaid due to his Lordship wherewith the same Benj: Sutton & Wm Clarke acknowledges themselves to be content

Ordered by this Court that the said Benj: Sutton give security for the part of the fine and due to the free School in the judgement above specified

Thereupon the same Benj: Sutton here into Court comes and also Wm Clarke of Kent County planter being present in Court in his proper person and they acknowledge themselves indebted
