Ordered by this Court that the fine and be debent
the Sheriff and thereupon the same Sheriff comes
and Acknowledges the receipt thereof.

Ordered by this Court that a writ be given for the

Thereupon the same Geo. Clarke of Kent County
planter and Geo. Jamieson of Kent County planter
present in Court in their proper persons and
did Acknowledge themselves Indebted to the Right
Honorable the Lord Proprietor in the sum of five
thousand pounds of tobacco each to make and levy
on their bodies goods & chattels lands and tenements
to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors
Conditionally that if the said Geo. John Jamieson
shall not pay and satisfy the fees and costs in the
Judgment and above mentioned where with the same
Geo. Clarke & Geo. Jamieson Acknowledge themselves
contented.

Ordered by the Court that a writ be given to keep
the County harmless from any charge that may
accrue by reason of the said Marye Ann Jackson
bearing a bastard Child by the said Geo. Clarke
