And now here at this court to wit at the Court house at the
Court house in the town of Shroton for said court on the
third tuesday in November being the thirteenth day of
said Month Anno Domini One thousand six hundred
thirty and four came the s^d Rich^d Hillingam and
in his proper person appeared and prayed that his
Recognizance be discharged as afo^r

Ordered by this Court here that the s^d Recognizance
be discharged as prayed

Rich^d Hillingam his Recognizance taken for
the sum of five pounds sterling for his appearance
as and evidence at the time and place afo^r against
a certain Robert Blackerby the same Recognizance
is by this Court here discharged

John Smith Wm^m Melland Rich^d Hillingam
and Dan Dullhunte all sworn as evidence
against the s^d Robert Blackerby after which
grand jury returned a bill of indictment against the
s^d Robert Blackerby for feloniously stealing one
bill of the value of ten shillings &c

And now here at the same court came the s^d Lord
prosecr by Sir Francis his atty and prays that the
s^d Robert to the s^d indictment may answer

And the s^d Robert in his proper person appeared

And the s^d Robert Blackerby in his proper person
comes and defends the force and injury when &c and
says that he is in no way sort guilty of the premises
above upon him imposed as by the s^d indictment
it is alleged and therefore he puts himself upon the
Country

And he who followeth for the Lord's property in like
manner says he is guilty

Ordered by the Court here that security be given for the
appearance of the s^d Rob^t Blackerby to the next Court
to be being the third tuesday in March next ensuing
