On the back of this same Indictment was
 Indorsed as follows to wit

We are ignorant of Sam Tovey foreman
 ordered by the Court that John Gresham Gent Sheriff
 of Kent County keep the said Sam Barton in his
 custody untill the fees accruing on the premises
 are satisfied

Ordered by the Court here that John Gresham Gent
 Sheriff of Kent County keep the said Sam Barton in
 his custody untill he shall enter into Recognizance
 for his good behaviour untill next Court

Thereupon the said Sam Barton of Kent Co
 says or profess here in his proper person comes and
 acknowledges himself indebted to the Right Honour-
 able the said Lord praying in the sum of Twenty pound current
 Money of Maryland to be made and levied on his body
 goods and Chattels Lands and tenements to the use
 of his Lordship his heirs and Successors conditionally
 that if he does not appear at our next Court to be
 held at our Court house in the town of Cheston in said
 County on the third Tuesday of ~~the~~ March Next and
 in the mean time to be of good behaviour wherewith he
 acknowledges himself content
