the aforesaid Edwards and appeared and prayed that her surety recogniz-
for her appearance be discharged — ordered by this Court
here that Daniel Dullahuntee his recognizance taken for the appear-
of the aforesaid Edwards for her appearance to this Court be discharged
as prayed Daniel Dullahuntee his recognizance taken in the sum

of three pounds current money of the province of Maryland &c. for the
appearance of the aforesaid Edwards at this November Court to receive
the punishment in the judgment aforesaid mentioned and in the mean time
she was to be of good behaviour This Court here discharges the same
recognizance there being no cause shown to the contrary &c.

And now here at this Court to wit at Kent County Court at the Court
house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in
November being the nineteenth day of said Month Anno Domini one
Thousand seven hundred and thirty four that John Gresham Esq
Sheriff of Kent County take the aforesaid Edwards into his custody and
execute fifteen lashes on her bare back till the blood appears as in
the judgment aforesaid coupled and afterwards to bring her into Court
again of which precept to wit John Gresham Esq Sheriff of Kent
County and makes return on the day and year last said that he
hath executed the punishment in the judgment aforesaid and also
brought here the said Joan Edwards before the Court —
