Be it remembered that on the second day of October Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty four came before me one John Hankins Justice for the afo County assigned John Hankins of Kent County Carpenter and John Clayton of Kent County planter and James Boyer of Kent County planter and acknowledged themselves indebted to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that is to say John Hankins in the sum of ten pounds Sterling and John Clayton and James Boyer in the sum of five pounds Sterling each to be made and levied on their bodies goods and Chastities Lands and Tenements to the use of His said Lordship his heirs and successors conditionally that if the afo John Hankins shall not make his personall appearance at the next Court to be held for Kent County at the Court house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in November next answering them and there to answer unto what shall be objected against him on his Lordships behalf for disobeying the authority of a Constable and in the mean time he is to be of good behaviour wherewith the said John Hankins acknowledges himself content and also John Clayton and James Boyer they acknowledge themselves content.
