The Sheriff of the County of Kent was given to the Sheriff of Kent County that he should immediately cause to come thereto twelve shillings by whomsoever who neither shillings to Proving shillings because as well shillings of which said precept the said Sheriff to wit John Gresham found none here at this day to wit the seventeenth day of June Anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and thirty and four makes return that he hath there ready twelve shillings. At by this precept he was commanded and now here afterwards to wit the day & year last mentioned come againe the aforesaid the Lord Property by Francis Tophy his atty and the aforesaid Robert in his proper person and the Jurors of that Jury being Impanelled and called Likewise came to wit that Ringgold John Carwell Robert Roberts Thomas Piner Jeremiah Livingston Alexander Bridger John Aldley William Browne William Massey Roger Hinks Edward Rogers jun. James Moore who being duly tryed and sworn to the same Robert Blackerby, appearing the Jurors aforesaid to say the truth in the promises upon their Oath do say that the aforesaid Robert Blackerby is guilty as he stands indicted and by that Ringgold therefore man aforesaid say Therefore it is concluded by the Justice there to wit at Kent County at the Court House in the Town of Chertsey in said County on the third Tuesday in June being the seventeenth day of said Month Anno Domini one Thousand Seven
