Ordered and thereby given That the said Robert Blackerby stand half an hour in the pillory and then to have on his bare back well laid on twenty one lashes like the blood appear for his committing the offence by the verdict of the jury and also pay unto John Smith forty Shillings current money the four for his goods and for his fine and also the sum of ~~four~~ ^{four} pounds of tobacco well answering on the promises and to the officers of this Court

It is also considered by the Court here at this day to wit the day and year last mentioned that the Sheriff of West County take the said Robert Blackerby into his custody and execute the punishment in the judgment and sentence and afterwards to bring him into Court again on a writ of habeas corpus to wit John Gresham Esq. High Sheriff of West County makes return on the day and year last said that he hath executed the punishment in the judgment and also hath here the said Robert Blackerby before the Court

Ordered by this Court that the said Robert be in the custody of the Sheriff of West County until the judgment and sentence was rendered

George Garnett at last Nov^r Court entered into recognizance for the appearance of the said Rob^t Blackerby to the then next March Court ensuing and the same March being Court until the next Court to come and all this here at this Court came the said Rob^t Blackerby in his proper person and appeared and prayed that the said George Garnett's recognizance for his appearance might be dissolved ordered by this Court here that the same recognizance be dissolved and George Garnett's recognizance as aforesaid taken in the sum of twenty pounds for the appearance of the said Robert Blackerby to answer unto an indictment of felony as aforesaid & to be of good behavior the said recognizance is by this Court here dissolved there being no cause shown to the contrary

John Smith at last Nov^r Court entered into recognizance as prosecutor & evidence against the said Rob^t Blackerby in the sum of ten pounds to appear at the then next March Court in Court and the same was Court until this present Court and now here at this Court to wit the third Tuesday in June Anno 1735 came the said John Smith and appeared and prayed his recognizance might be dissolved ordered by this Court here that the same recognizance be dissolved as prayed

John Smith's recognizance as aforesaid taken in the sum of ten pounds ~~current~~ ^{current} money for his appearance as aforesaid be discharged there being no cause shown to the contrary
