

And the same William Simcocks comes and defends
 the former Injury when he said Sayetto that he
 cannot gain say the Informations of So as of a gain
 it him brought nor can he say but that he is guilty
 of the premises above upon him imposed as by
 of Information it is alleged and thereof he submits
 to the Court Therefore it is considered by
 Justice here to wit at Hunt County at Court house
 in the Town of Chester in said County on the third
 Tuesday of November being the Nineteenth day of
 said Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred
 thirty and four that the said Wm Simcocks be fined
 five hundred pounds of Tobacco according to Act of
 Assembly in such case made and provided And
 that two hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco shall
 the sum of the abovesaid five hundred pounds of
 Tobacco be applyd to the use of his Lordships and
 that the remaining part two hundred and fifty
 pounds of Tobacco be applyd for and to the free school
 in said County and it is ^{also} considered that the same
 William Simcocks pay the sum of two hundred &
 fifty ^{two} pounds of Tobacco costs accruing on the
 premises afo: to the officers of this Court.

At His Lordships. The said Wm being constable
