 to Act of Assembly in such case made and provided

 Tobacco be apply'd to the use of his Lordship
 and that the remaining Two Hundred and fifty
 pounds of Tobacco be apply'd for and to the free
 School in said County, and it is also considered
 that the same Wm Simcocks pay the sum of Two
 Hundred and fifty ^{one} pounds of Tobacco loste arising
