 Sassafras Hundred in the County aforesaid planter on the

 our Lord God Seventeen Hundred thirty and two and
 all ways afterwards untill the day of the Exhibition
 of this Information being an Inhabitant and Resident
 within the said Hundred and County and within the
 Jurisdiction of this Court and a fit man to Execute the office
 of a Constable in the Hundred and County aforesaid was legally
 and in due form chosen and there Elected and Appointed
 to be the Constable of the said Hundred of which said
 Election and Appointments the said William afterwards
 to Wit the same day and year last above mentioned at
 the place aforesaid had Notice and the Oath of a Constable of the
 Hundred aforesaid in due form of Law did take and the said
 was and continued Constable of the said Hundred from
 the said third Tuesday of November Anno Domini Seventeen
 Hundred thirty and two aforesaid untill the Twenty first
 day of June Anno Domini Seventeen Hundred thirty and
 three to wit at the Hundred aforesaid within the said County
 and Jurisdiction Nevertheless the said William his duty
 of his said Office of Constable of the said Hundred aforesaid
 in this part nothing regarding on the twentieth day
 of June in the same year or at any time before did
 not repair in person to the dwelling house of Philomous
 Church of the said Hundred and County planter the
 same Philomous same day and year and for a long
 time next before at the Hundred aforesaid being a house
 keeper the master of a family and a taxable person
 and upward being and there require of the said
 Philomous a true list under his hand of all his taxable
 persons distinctly to be made which he had in his
 family but to do altogether did Neglect against
 the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made
