Government and against the form of the Acts of the
Assembly in such case lately made and provided &c.
Whereupon the same Atty for the said Lord Proprietary
for the same Lord Proprietary prayeth the advice of
the Court herein the premises and that due process
of Law in this part may issue against the said Tho:
to answer unto the same Lord Proprietary of and
upon the premises &c.

Thereupon Command is given on this Ninetieth
day of November in the Twentieth year of our Lord's
Dominion Anno Domini One thousand Seven Hundred
Thirty and four to the Sheriff of Kent County that
he shall take Thomas Tabor of Lower South Sasparas
Hundred in the County aforesaid planter if he should be
found in his Bailiwick and him safekeep so that
he have his body before our Justices of said County Court
to be held at our Court house in the town of Cheston in
said County of this third Tuesday of November next
for to answer unto a certain Information for not
providing in person to the dwelling house of a
certain James Hear of the said Hundred and County
planter and there require a true list under his
hand of all his taxable persons distinctly to be made
which he had in his family but so to do altogether
did neglect against the form of the Acts of Assembly
in such case made &c. and that the Sheriff of Kent
