And now here the same day and year last mentioned
came the aft Thomas Vason and in his proper person
appear And the same Tho Vason comes and defends
the force and injury when &c and sayeth that he cannot
gain say the Information of so as aft against him brought
nor can he say but that he is guilty of the premises above
upon him imposed as by the aft Information it is alleged
and therefore he submit to the Court Therefore it is
considered by the Justices heretofore at Kent County
at the Courthouse in the town of Chertsey in said County
on the third Tuesday of November being the Nineteenth day
of said month Anno Domini 1734 that the aft Thomas Vason be fined
the sum of five Hundred pounds of Tobacco according
to the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided and
that Two Hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco halfe
of the sum of the above said five Hundred pounds of Tobacco
be applied to the use of his Lordship And the remaining
of Two Hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco be applied
for and to the free school in said County and it is also
considered that the same Thomas Vason pay the
sum of Two Hundred and fifty one pounds
of Tobacco lost arising on the premises aft
to the Officers of this Court
