Thereupon Comenand is given on the thirteenth day of November in the twentieth year of our Lord Dominion Anno Domini One thousand Seven Hundred and thirty four to the Sherife of Kent County that he shall take Thomas Rason of Lower South Lakas as Hundred in the County and plaintiff if he should be found in his Bailiwick and him safe keep so that he have his body before our Justices of said County Court at the Court house in the town of Heston in said County of the third Tuesday in November Instant to answer unto a certain Information for not repairing in person to the dwelling house of a certain Edward Rason of the said Hundred and County plaintiff and there require a true list under his hand of all his taxable persons distinctly to be made which he had in his family but so to do altogether did neglect against the form of the act of Assembly in such case made &c. and that the Sherife of Kent County have at the time and place of the said Writ &c.

At which said third Tuesday of November being the Nineteenth day of said Month Anno Domini Seventeen Hundred Thirty and four the day of return of said Writ came Sir Gresham Gent Sherife of Kent County and made return thereof to the Court here thereon Indorsed as follows Vizt
